The Franklin County Board of County Commissioners agreed to write this letter voicing our objection to Senate Bill 550 which will require that on-site sewage treatment systems, i.e. septic tanks, must be pumped out and inspected once every five years. We ask that this legislation be repealed as it puts an undue financial hardship on our residents who use these systems. There are currently in place regulations dealing with systems that are failing which require that the system be pumped out and repaired or replaced. It is our position that these new regulations will add unnecessary financial burden to those who use private systems which are operating satisfactorily.

We urge you to reconsider this legislation and repeal this unnecessary requirement. Thank you for your consideration and we hope that you will support this effort.
